

Handbook Of Nonprescription Drugs 17th Edition Pdf Download Full

There is a guide on what to do if you accidentally take the wrong dose, what to do if you overdose, and what to do if you overdose with multiple drugs. Drugs that interact with prescription drugs are clearly marked, and the first page of each chapter contains a chart identifying the possible interactions between that drug and others in the chapter. Side effects of drugs are described in a similar fashion, and the associated drug interactions are clearly marked. This is an area in which many medications can be problematic and this is a helpful section to know. The pharmacology section is large and very clearly organized. The chapter includes the drug name and active ingredient(s), pharmacology including side effects, mechanism of action, therapeutic use, safety, dosage, and a list of drugs with similar activity.
